- Research data in Navy Enterprise Resource Planning (N-ERP) 1.1 Warehouse Management within the ERP Single Supply Solution and the Configuration Management Professional (CMPRO) software application for comparison analysis.
- After inventory counts and comparative analysis, enter physical inventory counts to data residing in the Physical Inventory (PI) module in N-ERP.
- Counting consists of the physical identification to the government provided inventory sheet and annotating the physical number counted to be identified as the ‘first’ count where the recorded quantity on-hand is not known to the counter.
- Upon return of count sheet for government review, all deviations from match require a ‘second’ count.

Physical Requirements:

- Able to lift and carry heavy objects up to 50 pounds.
- Work at heights up to 20 feet above the deck using proper safety equipment.
- Extended periods of sitting and/or standing.
- Position may require bending, stooping, crouching, climbing ladders, reaching, pulling, and lifting.
- Able to operate a forklift (rotation of head, peripheral vision, etc.)
- Able to work in a warehouse environment.
